Requirements

The Minor in East Asian Studies has the following requirements:

- 1. Three courses (or proficiency determined by the minor advisor) in Japanese or another East Asian language. (Language courses may be allocated in any of the three thematic categories, but there may be no more than one language course in any category.)
- 2. Four courses selected from the following:
