PART-TIME STUDENT

Enrollment in at least 12 credits of course work in any one term constitutes being a Full-Time Student. A student enrolled for fewer than 12 credits of course work in any one term is classified as a Part-Time Student or Special Student. For more information, see Classification of Students (https://catalog.rose-hulman.edu/rules-procedures/classification-students/).

Guidelines

A student may register as a Part-Time Student or reduce their course load to become a Part-Time Student at their discretion. Being a Part-Time Student may have implications for:

- · Financial aid and student loan repayment
- Insurance
- · Visa status for international students
- · Eligibility for athletics
- · Scheduling of required courses with prerequisites
- · Other individual-specific concerns

Students intending to be a Part-Time Student should discuss these implications with their advisor and a representative from the Financial Aid Office, if appropriate. International students must discuss their intention to be a Part-Time Student with the Director of International Student Services.

Limitations

Academic probation can only be removed for satisfactory work as a Full-Time Student at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology.

If a student wishes to be a Part-Time Student for more than two quarters (consecutive or non-consecutive), permission must be requested from the Admissions and Standing Committee. Before granting permission for a third term of Part-Time study, the Committee will evaluate whether the student is making satisfactory academic progress.
